Morgan Memorial Park Glen Cove, Long Island, NY



Morgan Memorial Park is located on the North Shore of Long Island in the City of Glen Cove. After acquiring the former steamboat landing, J.P. Morgan hired the most skilled landscape architects in New York to construct a park in memory of his late wife.

The 40-acres of land are situated at the mouth of Hempstead Harbor and include a picnic area, bathing beach, playground, stage area, gazebo, and a hiking path along the bluffs that overlook the harbor. The park is home to the Morgan Park Summer Music Festival offering free concerts during the summer months.
